ADVANCED CERTIFICATE IN NONPROFIT LEADERSHIP

| Moving beyond management into effective leadership.

The **Duke Advanced Certificate in Nonprofit Leadership** is a comprehensive program that offers experienced nonprofit professionals the opportunity to enhance their leadership skills through a theoretical study using reflective practices. The goal is to strengthen the capacities of leaders to lead and carry out the mission of their organizations.

Supported in part by the Blue Cross and Blue Shield of North Carolina Foundation, the Advanced Certificate is designed to foster leaders grounded in practice and centered on the edge. The Program was created in direct response to requests from senior nonprofit managers and many graduates of Duke's nationally acclaimed Certificate in Nonprofit Management.

The faculty is composed of nationally known experts from Duke University and elsewhere who provide resources to deepen and expand leadership skills. The Advanced Certificate consists of three tightly integrated symposiums: The Vessel of Leadership; The Voice of Leadership; and The View of Leadership.

Before registering for the Program, individuals must apply and be accepted into the Advanced Certificate in Nonprofit Leadership. The Program is open to those who hold the Certificate in Nonprofit Management and have 7 years of senior management experience. It is also open to persons not holding the Certificate in Nonprofit Management but have 10 years of senior management experience (application online, at

www.learnmore.duke.edu/certificates/nonprofitleadership). Individuals who apply and are accepted into the Advanced Certificate will participate in its three tightly integrated parts—a series of symposia over a period of 8 days.

Fee: \$3,750 (includes tuition, materials, and meals)

- Cultivate greater awareness and understanding of emerging leadership styles
- Discover future trends and challenges they bring.
- Acquire tools for reframing leadership in its current context.
- Learn reflective practices that enhance communication and foster understanding.
- Explore the role of ethics and values as a fundamental cornerstone of leadership.
- Be inspired by stories of extraordinary leadership.
- Learn processes for use in inquiry and advocacy.
